ROAD SAFETY MATTERS

I feel certain that you will all be aware that there were two accidents during the afternoon.

Whilst I'm pleased to say that both riders involved were home within a few days, it's still a serious concern to me that we had to make two calls to the emergency services.

[The following comments are general observations, and are not addressed at the injured parties or their teams.]

I've had some time to reflect on what we can all do to reduce the chances of any further accidents. My conclusion is that everybody needs to remember that despite the desire to get in the prizes or the medals, we are competing on the public roads, and certain behaviours (in addition to the obligation not to break The Law) are unacceptable.

At junctions in particular, riders really must approach in the knowledge that they can negotiate the turn safely, recognising that any marshals present are not doing any traffic management. Keeping to the left of the white lines, both before and after making the turning, should be standard practice and easily achieved.

I feel there may need to be some pressure to stop riders pushing the limits. As such, I'm considering imposing a time penalty on teams where a rider crosses the centre line at or around either of the major t-junctions on the course. I would be interested to hear your views on this idea.

BRIAN PHILLIPS

I first met Brian at races in the 1980s. We occasionally spoke when standing at result boards. Those of us who were keen to feature in the British Best All-Rounder (BBAR) competition for time triallists would often find that the same group of people would appear each weekend at whichever 50 mile, 100 mile or 12 hour event was the 'fashionable' choice. He was fighting it out for wins, where I was somewhat further down the result.

In the last 10 years, the emphasis for both of us seemed to have changed to odd-distance sporting TTs. As with decades earlier, he was still in the prizes...

I mentioned to him that I had started promoting the Team Time Trial, and suggested that he might like to get together with some of his buddies from the 80s, and put a team in.

When he agreed, I commented that I would need to find a race sponsor, to be sure to offer him some decent prizes. His response was to immediately offer to sponsor the race himself! I hadn't expected that, but accepted the offer. And with Brian's backing, the event has grown to what it is today.

Earlier this year, he wrote to me confirming that he would once again back the TTT. He mentioned that on March 27th he was riding an 8-up Team Time Trial in Italy, and joked that this would be ideal preparation for the Antelope event 3 weeks later.

Alas, the race in Italy was his last. Anyone who ever met Brian will have been shocked to hear of his death.

I knew immediately that the Antelope TTT should be dedicated to his memory. His family agreed to this, and his wife Claire kindly stepped in with the sponsorship that had originally been offered for 2011.



I feel privileged to have known Brian. Like many others, I have lost a dear friend and a fantastic person.
